It is well known that person centred approaches are much more likely to be embedded in an organisation when those in leadership roles are committed to working in this way. This workshop is unique in that it is designed for those who can influence the culture and functioning of the organisation as a whole.

WHO THE WORKSHOP IS FOR

If you are in a leadership role, are in a position to make decisions and want to adopt person centred approaches at an organisation-wide level, then this workshop is for you. It is recommended that more than one person from an agency attends so that follow-up in a team situation is

possible. This makes it much more likely that the insights from the workshop can be applied.

This workshop is foundational (though not a pre-requisite) to the other workshops in this series (see over page for the list of workshops).
